REVIEW OF EXPERIENCE AND / OR EDUCATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Persons moving into North Dakota wishing to complete the process for registration in order to practice as a Registered Pharmacy Technician in North Dakota *MUST* comply with the following process, if they have not completed an American Society of Health Systems (ASHP) accredited educational program.

The following documents must be completed and sent to the Pharmacy Technician Program Office:

- O Verification of prior employment as a pharmacy technician including:
 - * Years of experience, noting full-time or part-time
 - * Detailed job description
 - * Letters of reference from former employers

- O Official transcript of training program completed (if not ASHP accredited)
 - * Program contact information
 - * Include course syllabi if possible

- O Official transcript of any post high school education

- O Letter of support from potential employer if one has been secured
