**NAPLEX**

- Need a Score of 75 to pass
- Can complete application prior to graduation, upon graduation NABP will verify eligibility with NDBOP (Usually on the Friday of graduation)

	Prior to Graduation	Complete 1 application for PRIMARY licensure state. Register at NABP website ( <a href="http://www.NABP.net">www.NABP.net</a> )

**MPJE (Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination)**

- Need a Score of 75 to pass
- Can complete application prior to graduation, upon graduation NABP will verify eligibility with NDBOP (Usually on the Friday of graduation)

	Prior to Graduation	Complete 1 application for EACH licensure state. Register at NABP website ( <a href="http://www.NABP.net">www.NABP.net</a> )

**North Dakota Practical Exam**

- a. Exam Occurs Tuesday & Wednesday after graduation in Fargo ND
  - i. E&O's, Compounding, Interview
- b. Application (found on [www.nodakpharmacy.com](http://www.nodakpharmacy.com)) has two parts:
  - ii. Part 1: Page one of application. Can be submitted without page two and will serve as written notification to NDBOP for examination – Upon receipt of Part 1 – The Board will send out the current Rules & Laws Book. Can be submitted at any time during P4 year.
  - iii. Part 2: Page two of application. Call or Email Liz in the Dean's Office and ask to have the second page filled out and submitted for you. This can be done after April 1<sup>st</sup> but must be completed at least 2 weeks prior to exam.
