\$35.00 fee covers the ND Pharmacy Law Book I will send to the address you have listed on this form.

You must complete the NABP Preliminary Application for Transfer of Pharmaceutic Licensure online at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy) they will send me your Official License Application [electronically ] the ND Board Reciprocity / License Transfer Fee is: \$150 + a onetime \$25 Original Certificate Fee.

Upon receipt of the electronic Official Application for Transfer of Pharmacist Licensure and the \$210 fee, you are eligible to sit for the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE). You must again apply online at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy) to sit for the MPJE. They will notify the ND Board and ask for verification of your eligibility. **IF** all your forms and fees are in order, we will authorize you to take the MPJE. NABP will then send you an authorization to test number, which you need to make an appointment to sit for the MPJE Examination.

Upon successful completion of the MPJE, I will proceed with your licensure in North Dakota as a Pharmacist.
