- Can complete application prior to graduation, upon graduation NABP will verify eligibility with NDBOP (Usually on the Friday of graduation)

	Prior to Graduation	Complete 1 application for PRIMARY licensure state. Register at NABP website (www.NABP.net)

MPJE (Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination)

- Need a passing score
- Can complete application prior to graduation, upon graduation NABP will verify eligibility with NDBOP (Usually on the Friday of graduation)

Completed	Due	Task
	Prior to Graduation	Complete 1 application for EACH licensure state. Register at NABP website (www.NABP.net)

North Dakota Practical Exam

- a. Exam Occurs Tuesday & Wednesday after graduation in Fargo ND
 - i. E&O's, Compounding, Interview
- b. Application (found on www.nodakpharmacy.com) has two parts:
 - ii. Part 1: Application for Examination . Can be submitted and will serve as written notification to NDBOP of intent to sit for the examinations – Upon receipt of the Application, photo and fee – The Board will send out the current Rules & Laws Book. This can be submitted at any time during P4 year.
 - iii. Part 2: Submit Affidavit/Progress Report of final year rotations to the Dean's Office for signature and notarization of graduation.

	Submit to Board 10 days prior to exam	Complete and Notarize Affidavit/Progress Report
