## REV April 24, 2013 INSTRUCTIONS FOR ANNUAL WHOLESALE LICENSE Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Distributor/Retailer and Medical Gas Distributor/Retailer

North Dakota law requires all businesses operating in North Dakota to be registered with the North Dakota Secretary of State's office. If your business and/or corporation is not registered with the North Dakota Secretary of State's office, **please register your business prior to applying for a North Dakota Board of Pharmacy (NDOBPh) license.** If your dba name is different than your corporation name, the Office of the North Dakota Secretary of State also requires a trade name or fictitious name registration.

## **License Class Description**

**DME or Medical Gas Distributor** – Providing products from licensed facility to authorized businesses and licensed practitioners in North Dakota.

**DME or Medical Gas Retailer** – Providing products from licensed facility directly to North Dakota residents pursuant to a practitioner's prescription. According to 43-15.3-10 and 43-15.3-11, the retailer must employ or contract with an in-state licensed professional who is authorized to prescribe or administer the DME or Medical Gas. Those individuals must be submitted with the application before a license will be issued.

## License Fee

\$200 – If operating as a Distributor or a Retailer of DME/Medical Gas
\$300 – If operating as BOTH a Distributor and a Retailer of DME/Medical Gas

**North Dakota Secretary of State System Identification #** Please include the number on your North Dakota Certificate of Authority. If you are using a dba name, also include the number on your North Dakota Trade Name or Fictitious Name Certificate. Attach a copy of the certificate(s) to your application.

<u>All Renewal Applications</u> must be completed by June 1<sup>st</sup> or they will be considered late and a delinquent fee will be accessed. You can renew your application online at <u>www.nodakpharmacy.com</u>.

<u>All questions</u> about registration with the North Dakota Secretary of State should refer to <u>www.nd.gov/sos/</u> where all of the Secretary of State information and application forms are available.

Complete applications will be processed as they arrive. If your application is incomplete, your license will not be issued until staff has had time to identify and verify the missing information.
